Governor Mitch Daniels Indiana Alcohol and Tobacco Commission will not enforce alcohol license laws until then, local law enforcement exercise the same common-sense approach.

That means bar owners can operate as usual overnight Saturday and remain open for the hours.

"Most of us will set our clocks ahead before we go to bed. They can do it when they're loc night," said Daniels. "And, by the way, we won't take away the extra hour they'll get when October."

All of Indiana will observe Daylight Saving Time for the first time on April 2 beginning at 2 daylight time begins on the first Sunday in April and ends on the last Sunday in October.

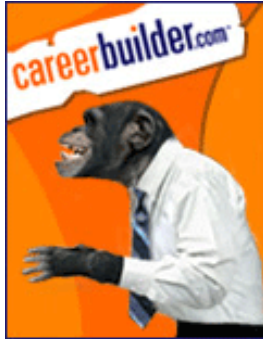
